

# TEACHING ASSISTANT WITH SPECIALISM LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

## Overview

A Teaching Assistant Apprentice forms a pivotal role in supporting a young person's development, working alongside the lead teacher to enhance pupils' learning, either in groups or individually, ensuring that pupils thrive in a positive, nurturing, safe environment.

On completion of this apprenticeship, you will hold a Level 3 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools.

Additional qualifications achieved include:

- Level 3 Diploma in Specialist Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools
- Level 2 Functional Skills Maths
- Level 2 Functional Skills English

Each Apprentice must undergo an independent end-point assessment to determine the outcome of their apprenticeship. The assessments will assess the knowledge, skills and behaviours gained during their programme. The methods in which this apprenticeship is assessed are:

- practical observation with questions & answers
- professional discussion supported by a portfolio of evidence

## Objectives

The programme:

- provides transferable skills such as the ability to keep children safe, communication, planning, health and safety for children, the ability to monitor children's behaviour, and underpinning the delivery of the national curriculum.
- gives learners the knowledge, skills, and behaviours, to support the class teacher to enhance pupils' learning, ensure that pupils understand the work set, know their learning objectives and stay on task in order to make progress.

<b>Audience</b>	New and experienced Teaching Assistants in either the primary, special or secondary education sector.
<b>Commitment</b>	12 months. Apprentices will be assigned a dedicated tutor. The tutor will visit monthly in the workplace, as well as being on hand to support throughout the duration of the apprenticeship programme.
