NPQ Senior Leadership (NPQSL)

Overview

Aimed at senior leaders with cross school responsibilities, the NPQSL gives participants all the essential knowledge, skills and concepts that underpin successful leadership of teaching and helps to develop your confidence to effectively take on a leadership role and support your team

The course is usually completed within 18 months with the production of a case study at its conclusion. This is a blended delivery model comprising 4 face to face events, online study, webinars and coaching. Eligibility is subject to evidencing support from your Headteacher to release you to undertake the course and related work.

Objectives

The programme:

- improves outcomes for pupils in participant areas of responsibility
- helps you critically evaluate your own leadership practice
- creates your own flexible study plan around work and personal commitments
- provides facilitation and support from serving school leaders

Senior Leaders Apprentice (with NPQSL) Level 5 funded through Apprenticeship Levy Overview

If you are not eligible for the scholarship, this dual award takes place over 18 months with participants submitting a summative assessment task at the end of the 18 months. Delivery comprises 4 face to face events, 3 facilitated online courses, quarterly school visits, monthly one to one review meetings, regular support webinars, work practice activity and end point assessment. There are two possible start dates per year, one in the autumn term and one in the spring term.
