

Advanced Skills Educational Coach Award

Overview

An advanced skills coach will use progressive strategies and approaches to assist others in defining what needs to be achieved, clarifying and valuing why it is important, and creating momentum. You will also learn how to empower commitment to action in colleagues that realises both professional and organisational aspirational goals.

As well as achieving this OLEVI Award, you will receive a diploma and be qualified as a Level 4 Coach. The accreditation process involves the observation of two coaching or mentoring conversations as well as professional discussion regarding your key learning.

Objectives

The programme:

- develops expert coaches whose honed active listening skills and ability to ask powerful questions will provide greater clarity to, and generate deep thinking in, those they work with.
- will accredit you to coach and mentor adults and pupils to improve their learning, leadership and well-being
- empowers you to design your own coaching models to fit your context and to develop coaching within a team by embedding a culture of continual, sustained improvement.
