Overview

Leaders that are highly reflective and resilient can learn and grow as their role develops over time.

As well as achieving the OLEVI accreditation, you will receive a Diploma and be qualified as a Level 5 Manager. The accreditation process involves a knowledge test as well as two professional discussions.

Objectives

The programme:

- enables you to create and implement strategic projects to achieve results
- helps you understand your own strengths and areas for development as a leader
- develops the skills to develop and grow their teams, through challenge, collaboration and feedback, so they can consistently deliver high outcomes
- provides the tools to systemically measure the knowledge and skills their team has developed at every stage of development. This means they can review the impact of their leadership – and adapt it if necessary.
- provides an opportunity to reflect openly and rationally on their own leadership and create an effective personal development plan to move forward.
