Facilities Managers work within individual schools or across a multi academy trusts of all sizes and scope. They are responsible for the safe, secure and comfortable day-to-day working environment for school properties, assets and services that must be fully compliant with health and safety and other legislation.

On completion of this apprenticeship, you will hold a level 4 Diploma Institute of Workplace and Facilities Management.

Objectives

The programme:

- prepares an individual for managing the delivery of all facilities management services within their area of responsibility
- ensures that level of performance delivered exceed school or multi-academy trust expectations within budget for the properties, assets and services.
- contributes to the delivery of the overall operational objectives of the school or multi academy trust.

Each apprentice must undergo an independent end-point assessment to determine the outcome of their apprenticeship. The assessments will evaluate the knowledge, skills and behaviours gained during their programme. The methods in which this apprenticeship is assessed are:

- work based project
- presentation to panel
- professional discussion with a panel based on the portfolio and reflective log.
